Achievements:

At ITN Business I suggested and implemented a new system to improve workflow. I suggested using a clapper board to provide a visual cue to identify the interviewee and the project so that at a glance these could be dropped into the correct project for editing. This helped speed up the sorting process and helped the editors find the correct interview to use.

In September 2023, my Dad and I took on the challenge of hiking the Tour Du Mont Blanc route. The route consisted of around 170 km of hiking and 10,000m of elevation, which we completed in 12 days. We carried all of our equipment through 30 degree heat, torrential rain and snow. We persevered and were rewarded with memories that will last a lifetime.
